

Herring Memorial Park

One of the beauty spots in Brunswick is the Herring Memorial Park. This spot was originally a camp and fair ground owned by Mr. Lloyd H. Herring, Sr. In 1952, the Herring family, in memory of Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Herring Sr., donated it to the city of Brunswick. Huge oak trees and grassy hills make up the terrain. There are now two shelter houses, complete with tables and benches, and several grills for preparing food. Playground equipment has been added for the children.

The park is used for camping, family gatherings, church services, school picnics, political rallies, and other outings.
